Educational Program in Medicine

- Lecture-practical courses for students of the 2nd and 4th semesters of the medicine program, in the basic and pre-clinical academic courses, will be conducted online during the first 4 weeks after the start of the semester. All types of teaching components provided by the syllabus will be held face-to face, on a university base, from week 5.
- Practical classes in clinical subjects will be conducted at clinics either fully face-to-face or in a hybrid format from the first week for 6th,8th, 10th and 12th semester students of the medicine program.

Educational Program in Dentistry

- Lecture-practical courses for students of the 2nd, 4th and 6th semesters of the dentistry program, in the basic and pre-clinical academic courses, will be conducted online during the first 4 weeks after the start of the semester. All types of teaching components provided by the syllabus will be held face-to face, on a university base, from week 5.
- Academic course "Emergency Medical Care" for second semester students of dentistry program will be held at the University Clinical Skills Center;
- Practical classes in clinical subjects will be conducted at clinics either fully face-to-face or in a hybrid format from the first week for 8th and 10th semester students of the dentistry program.

Educational Program in Pharmacy

- The first 4 weeks will be held online for students of the 2nd, 4th 6th and 8th semesters of the pharmacy program, in the basic and pre-clinical academic courses, will be conducted online during the first 4 weeks after the start of the semester. All types of teaching components provided by the syllabus will be held face-to face, on a university base, from week 5.
- Academic course "First Aid" for 6th semester students of pharmacy program will be held at the University Clinical Skills Center;
- The subject "Pharmaceutical Technologies Drug Factory Technology (Practice)" will be implemented on the object of practice for 8th semester students of pharmacy program.
