

Tallinn University announces full stipends for studying in the Master program [Human Rights in the Digital Society](#)

The Master program is conducted in English in two years. Its goal is to address new developments and challenges in law and society that have arisen in connection with the ever-increasing digitalization. The program is unique among European universities, being taught by scholars producing cutting-edge research and being connected to global networks of human rights and the digital domain.

The conditions of the stipend are the following: full tuition fee for two years' worth 8120 euro and a contribution to cover the living costs in Estonia 400 euro per month (in each academic year for the total of 10 months), so in total 8000 euro. **The total value of the scholarship is therefore 16 120 euro.**

All applicants from the target countries are automatically considered for the scholarship. Scholarships are allocated to the best applicants based on the admissions ranking lists. **Application deadline is 12 August 2020. We encourage early applications in order to allow sufficient time for processing and interviews.**

**NB! Students who are not able to arrive physically to Estonia due for the start of studies in September 2020 will be able to start classes online in real time. They have to arrive at the University when the circumstances permit. The stipend covers also online studies, monthly living allowance will be paid from the time when the student arrives in Estonia.**
